Precautions for Pet animals in Monsoon Season

- High moisture/humidity content during monsoon season
- Season for illness to Pet animals and even Birds too
- Exposure to cold can lead to respiratory problems, even pneumonia can occur.
- Less exposure to direct sunlight leads to Rickets in weak puppies.
- Spread of infections which are food and water borne are more common in this season.
- Gastro-intestinal problems and infections are more prevalent.
- Vomition and loose motions are common symptoms. May be bacterial or even viral are not uncommon.
- Viral gastro- intestinal infections are more fatal causes severe dehydration, may even leads to death, if not attended on time.
- Giving warm food is often advisable.
- Fungal infections are seen due to constant wetting of animals.
- Cleaning and grooming of pet, drying body coat is advisable. Apply anti-fungal powder over skin to prevent allergic skin reactions.
- Frequent internal parasite infestation is also common where deworming with appropriate medicine is suggested.
- Contact with other dogs is frequent in this season. Avoid mixing with other dogs of unknown origin.
- Due to heavy rains proper exercise is not possible leading to lack of appetite so design feeding schedule accordingly.
- Provide food and water in separate bowls which are of metal vessels. Metal vessels are easy to clean.
- Water is many time s contaminated so ensure clean and constant source of fresh drinking water periodically.
- Give less food with frequent intervals to avoid possible indigestion.
- Avoid giving kitchen waste and non-veg left-over food.

- To provide proper immunity to your pet offer feed which is balanced. Supplement with proteins, vitamins and minerals.
- Protect your Pet with all types of vaccines when healthy.
- Booster vaccination dose is recommended in Manson season.
- Cleaning of paws and ears are very important.
- Avoid frequent bathing.
- Ticks and flea control with proper medication is also important.
- Provide dry bedding or a wooden platform to pets when kept outside.
- Avoid spraying of insecticides and pesticides in garden which might cause accidental poisoning.
- Wounds and injuries are common and usually wounds healing is delayed in monsoon.
- MAGGOTS are more common and needs attention in time.
- In case of puppies along with mother provide extra heat arranging 100 watts heating bulb.
- Special heaters can be arranged in a room according to need in cold.
- House flies menace is more common in this season.
- Flies are responsible for transmission of disease very fast.
- Locally and on pets body fly repellant sprays can be used effectively
